A display reflecting the project will be in all partner schools. 20 appropriate words will be added to The Rainbow Project dictionary. To celebrate the end of this project each partner school will host a party for elderly citizens in our community. Displays of each celebration will be in each partner school. 20 appropriate words will be added to The Rainbow Project dictionary.
